
We would like to thank our chairman Mr M D Jambhekar and secretary Mr Abhay Kulkarni for giving us the opportunity and platform for conducting the event.


Staff: Various vaccine brands approved for Indian population and their individual features: a comparative evaluation

Health screening & Ergonomic camp at ATSS, CITY PRIDE SCHOOL Nigadi & HCMR Nigadi.

On occasion of 'World Physiotherapy Day' 2021, CMF's College of Physiotherapy, Chinchwad had organized and conducted a Health screening and Ergonomic camp in the sister institutes ATSS CBSCBA Chinchwad, City Pride School Nigadi & IICMR College Nigadi on 16-9-21, 18-9-2021 & 21-9-21 respectively.

The camp team consisting of 4 teachers Dr Shweta Naidu along with Dr Madhur Kulkarni, Dr Priti Patil & Dr Pratima Sarwadikar, 7 PG and 4 UG students visited each college and conducted the camp.

The teaching and non-teaching staff of the school & college were assessed on the basis of flexibility, endurance, fatigue and quality of life and was followed by counseling session by the team. There were 5 stations created which assessed the participants. Each station was handled by a team of two members each who assessed and recorded the data.

Station 1: registration and basic vital evaluation,

Station 2: flexibility evaluation using sit and reach test,

Station 3: endurance testing using sit to stand test

Station 4: Quality of life using SF 12 questionnaire

Station 5: Fatigue assessment using fatigue assessment scale.

A small interactive lecture was delivered at IICMR college Nigadi by Dr. Shweta Naidu, Assistant Professor Department of Musculoskeletal science, where she spoke about Covid 19 infection, problems related to Covid 19 infections, how sedentary lifestyle in teachers is affecting their health and what all measures can be taken to avoid the problem of sedentary behavior. A small exercise demonstration was done and the participants actively performed the exercises. A total of 193 participants had been assessed which were as ATSS: 38 (33F, 5M), CITY PRIDE: 103 (95F, 8M), IICMR: 56 (32F,24M). The participants were teachers of various groups ie teachers from schools, junior colleges, undergraduate college to post graduate colleges. The age group assessed varied from between 25 to 60 years of age including 37 Males & 156 females. The participants were also assessed on the basis of history of Covid 19 infection and counseling was done accordingly by the team.

It wouldn't have been possible without the constant support of the teaching and non-teaching staff of all the 4 Institutes who helped us in successful conduction of the camps.

The judges for the event were Dr Sushil Arora & Dr Ashish Bele. The winners for the events




The workshop contained theory lectures and interactive activities related to questionnaire designing and validation. Students actively participated in group activities.






Report of Lecture on Rainwater Harvesting
